  - 1. Reserve Study Workshop on April 17, 2024 by Browning Reserve Group as defined by the Community Associations Institute; "a reserve study is a budget planning tool which identifies the current status of the reserve fund and a stable and equitable funding plan to offset the anticipated major common area expenditures consisting of two parts: the physical analysis and financial analysis"

Relevant information: Reserve study had not been approved by the Board of Directors. Physical analysis was not the focus of the workshop presentation. There is a 30-year forecast/ estimation of costs. The current reserve fund is very low in respect to current mandated repairs/ renovations and future maintenance. The threshold funding method was used, that is keeping the reserve balance above a specified dollar or percent funding amount and no supplemental funding, such as loans was factored into the analysis

**Resulting Conclusions/ Recommendations**: Over the next three-year period, increase monthly HOA dues up to 15%, which can be done without voting, and direct that money to the reserve fund. Collect a special assessment, *averaging* \$2,750 and \$700, respectively, from each unit over the next two years to increase the reserve
